DIRECTIONS

Respecting the manner in which Entries may be made in the *Encyclopædia Britannica*.

After "City or Borough," write the name, if City Director is in a City or Borough; if not, write "Not through such name, or through whichever of the two the Director now belongs to." After "Postmaster Thursday of," write the name, if there is a Township in the Parish, else a line through "Postmaster of"; if it is a Township, write the name of the Township, and close it with a line through "Postmaster." If it is a Rural Postoffice, close a line through "Postmaster of," and write "Rural Postmaster" over these words, and close the name.

In the column headed, "Places," with the name of the house 1935 has a word or words of the street or other part of descriptive name of the village, hamlet, or town-mentioned place in which it stands, opposite to the mark during each house, in the first page in the series, Sec., and table "A," according to either in the same order, Sec.

"*Magnus*"—class houses established as building. In the number shown in the Example, writing "1 G" or "1 E" at the top may be in the proper column, opposite the individual house to which such name applies. Name houses which are unoccupied at the time of your visit and is believed not to have been slept in the night before, may also be listed as unoccupied. "New houses, not yet inhabited, may be entered as "Building." When there is a row of such houses the total number may be entered before the letter B, instead of the number, in front of each.

By "house" is meant dwelling-house; and every building in which any person lawfully sleeps must be so construed as a dwelling-house; but buildings, such as stables or warehouses, or any other, which when used or intended to be used as dwellings, must not be so construed.

"Names of such Persons who check theirin the preceding night."—There, without doubtless in
such houses, many living persons who sleep at night in such houses, and such persons as those mentioned in the list, will each have

c. Which designation is a form of address, the title may be written instead of the name. The words "Lord," "Lady," "Sir," "Madam," "Mister," or "Miss" before the name of those to whom they belong.

This distinction has been given more fully under "N. S." for *not known*, with the Example.

As may happen in a lodging-house or inn, a person who slept there the night before, has gone away, the name is not known, write "n/a" where the name should have been.

At the end of the process of each family drew a question for all the members. At the end of the session of the members in each house drew a brittle box with a

"Age and Sex."—While the age of each person opposite to the name is one of the two columns headed "Age and Sex," it is not the same as the "Age and Sex" column.

Write the age of every person under 15 years of age as it is named to you. For persons aged 15 years and over, write the age of the person as he or she appears to you.

INTRODUCTION

THIS booklet offers a complete A-Z listing of all the entries in the 1841-1911 censuses for the townships of Newsham and adjoining New Forest. It is a companion to Barningham Local History Group's first volume of local census returns, which covered Barningham, Scargill and Hope.

Newsham lies in two parishes, Barningham and Kirby Ravensworth, and the census enumerators listed the people in each parish separately. We have put them all together, but given each entry an identification number to make it clear in which parish they lay. Entries for New Forest, in Kirby Ravensworth parish, are similarly differentiated.

We have done our best to ensure that the details here are a true reflection of the census returns, but readers should bear in mind that not all of them were complete or wholly accurate. For a discussion of the problems faced by census-takers and the resulting omissions and inaccuracies, see the introduction to the first volume.

We hope this booklet proves useful to anyone seeking to trace their ancestors from this part of North Yorkshire. If you have amendments or further information, please let us know and we will incorporate them into future editions.

SORTING OUT THE ABBREVIATIONS

THE first page of the 1841 enumerator's notebook – see previous page – carried lengthy directions for how the census should be carried out.

Much of it is straightforward, and it explains some of the mysterious abbreviations you might come across when searching through the records. MS, for example, means manservant, FS female servant. Others include Ag Lab - Agricultural labourer, Ap - Apprentice, C - Clerk, F - Foreigner, I - Irish, Ind - Living on independent means, J - Journeyman, M - Manufacturer, m - maker (as in shoe-m.), P - pensioner (army or navy), S - Scots and Sh - Shopman.

No titles were to be recorded – “Rank, or any such term as ‘Esq’ or ‘Gentleman’ must not be entered”, say the directions sternly – except those of the upper classes: “Where the person is a Peer or Peeress the title may be written instead of the name. The words ‘Lord’, ‘Lady’, ‘Sir’, ‘Rt Hon’ and ‘Hon’ may be put before the names of those to whom they belong.”

SEVEN QUESTIONS

THE first census form asked for seven pieces of information about every dwelling and the people there that night:

- The address
- Whether the dwelling was inhabited
- If so, the names of everyone there
- Their age and sex
- Their profession, trade or employment, if any
- Whether they were born in the county in which they were recorded
- Whether they were born outside England or Wales.

SOMEWHERE IN THE VILLAGE...

NOT all the census enumerators tried to identify individual houses, merely recording them as 'village' and listing them in whatever order they came to hand, which makes it difficult today to trace their footsteps round a village. It wasn't entirely their fault.

Although house numbering had been introduced in some areas in the 18th century, it had yet to reach places like Newsham (it still hasn't, apart from a handful of houses), and in 1841 only a few dwellings in the village, the farms and grander houses, had names. It was not until the back end of the 19th century that ordinary people started to name the places in which they lived, and even in 1901 many of the village's recorded dwellings were still anonymous.

IS HE A LUNATIC?

THE 1861 census introduced a new question, asking whether people were blind, deaf or dumb. Nobody minded, and those who were disabled in this way were, as far as we can tell, accurately recorded.

Encouraged by this, those in charge in 1871 extended the question to ask in addition whether they were an imbecile, an idiot or a lunatic. The response this time was quite different. Nobody wanted to admit that they'd sired a lunatic, and hardly any were recorded.

In 1911 they changed the wording to 'feeble-minded'. This wasn't so bad, and the number of people recorded as having what today would be described as 'learning difficulties' soared.

They don't ask that kind of question today. Instead they just ask whether the head of the household looks after anyone suffering from longterm mental ill-health or disability.

THE SHRINKING VILLAGE

THERE were 398 people living in the Newsham census area in 1841, occupying 99 separate buildings; another 12 were standing empty.

Seventy years later, in 1911, the number of homes had shrunk to 60 and the population had dropped by more than a third to 268.

It had been even lower than that in the later 1880s, down to 206 in 1891, for reasons yet to be fully explored.

There was a similar decline in the number of buildings recorded as inhabited, down to 60 in 1911. Some of this reflects houses falling into permanent disuse or being turned into agricultural buildings, but it was also a time when many tiny cottages were being merged into larger dwellings.

The drop in the population in the late Victorian years was at least partly due to increasing

mechanisation of agriculture – women farm labourers seems to have been particularly hard-hit – and the parallel lure of factory work in the towns.

Birth rates fell in Newsham during this period, as elsewhere. In 1851 eleven families were recorded with five or more children at home; in 1901 only three.

New Forest suffered a much more dramatic population decline between 1841 and 1911. At the start of this period there were 73 people living in 14 dwellings; by the end numbers had dropped to 39 in eight.

- The Newsham census area, based on the parish boundaries, comprised the village itself and outlying farms.
- The figures below exclude scholars at the boarding school, almost all of whom were boys – See the Appendix for details.

READING THE LISTS

ENTRIES are listed by surname, census year, census record number as in original census, a unique household identification name (eg Smith1); abode on census day (if known); first name, age and marital status, then (in brackets) relationship to household head, occupation and birthplace.

Household heads are listed first, then (as far as is known) spouse, children in order of age, other family members of same surname and then, preceded by a + sign,, other household members with different surnames: these are also listed separately.

In early censuses many ages for adults were rounded down to the nearest five years; later ones were more accurate but it is clear many people were uncertain about their exact birth years and/or got confused about (or disguised) their ages in later life.

A census has been held every ten years since 1801 apart from the one due in 1941, cancelled because of the war. Most 1931 records were lost forever in a fire but there was an abbreviated population count in September 1939.

Census records are kept secret for 100 years. The 1921 records have been released but are only available online at considerable cost. Most can nevertheless been seen on this website.

In 1881 Abraham Nightman, 41, married, a scavenger born in Bowes, was living at Midden Cottage, numbered 94 in the Newsham census records, with his wife Isabella (39, born in Newsham), their two children Albert, 7, born in Bowes, and Newsham-born Mary, 5, his mother-in-law Martha Haggard, and girl called Agnes Knightley.

The birthplaces of the two youngsters suggest that the family moved to the village from Bowes around 1875. Abraham is recorded as having died in 1883. As well as being noted here, Martha and Agnes are listed separately, and more details about them can be found by looking them up under Haggard and Knightley. By doing so you may find that they have appeared in earlier censuses, and you can trace back their families.

In 1891 Abraham's widow was living at Marsh Top with Mary; her mother had presumably died, though there's no burial record. Albert, meanwhile, was unmarried and working as a farmhand for a family called Brown at Far End Farm, listed No 9 in the New Forest census. More details about them can be found by looking up Brown on the list.

A second family called Nightman had arrived by 1891: James from Gilmonby, farming 52 acres at Bull Close, his Cockfield-born wife Margaret, and their two-month-old daughter Ella, born in Newsham.

In 1901, there was no record of the first family, who had presumably left the area, but the second one remained with the addition of a son called John.
