# INTRODUCTION

**T**HE first British census as we know it was in 1801, the result of years of campaigning by a young government statistician called John Rickman. He was convinced that the country, facing the threat of Napoleonic invasion, urgently needed to know exactly how many men were available for conscription into the army or navy in the event of war, and where they were. He finally won the backing of the Prime Minister, Pitt the Younger, and in 1800 his Census Act (its full title was *An Act for taking Account of the Population of Great Britain, and of the Increase or Diminution Thereof*) passed successfully through Parliament.

Rickman was put in charge of carrying out the first census, and the next three that followed in 1811, 1821 and 1831. They were very limited operations, not much more than headcounts, and contained very little personal information. Sadly, none of them survive (though even if they did they wouldn't be much use to us).

Rickman died in 1840, just before the next census was due. The General Register Office took over and decided it would like to know not just how many people lived where, but also what they were called, how old they were, where they had been born, and how they made a living. (A pity that it didn't ask how people in each household were related to each other: that came a decade later).

The country was divided into registration districts and further divided into sub-districts overseen by officials known as enumerators, often local schoolmasters appointed because they were thought to be literate, numerate, and therefore best-fitted to carry out the work.

They in turn appointed collectors whose job was to visit every dwelling the morning after census day and pick up forms that had been distributed earlier for completion by the household heads. These they returned to the enumerator, who copied the details into enumeration books which were sent to the government for compilation into the nationwide survey.

It worked reasonably well, but there were some difficulties. Ages of people up to 15 were supposed to be recorded precisely, but those older than that had their age rounded down to the nearest five years, so anyone aged 49 was listed as 45, 64-year-olds were said to be 60, and so on. Quite a few people were missed off the lists. Some were simply not at home, some were on night work, some were travelling, some on holiday. Crews on ships and inland waterway vessels were omitted. There was a common misbelief that unbaptised infants need not be recorded.

Some parents with large families kept children secret to avoid accusations of over-crowding, and other children were said to be older than they were to escape investigation into under-age employment.

The age of consent in 1841 was 21, and there must have been some people under that age who pretended to be older than they were so that they could enter into legal contracts, such as renting a home. And some women must have been tempted, then as

now, to knock a few years off their public age. The truth about some relationships was hidden, too. There were couples living together but unmarried (though it was not anything like as common as today) and this was sometimes disguised on the census forms by describing the female partner as a servant or housekeeper.

Illegitimate children were not unknown, and although the 1841 census did not ask about parenthood, the 1851 one did. To avoid public shame, such children were sometimes described as nephews or nieces, or as the offspring of the unmarried mother's parents, skipping a generation.

By no means all householders could fill in the form, truthfully or otherwise, for the simple reason that they could not read or write. Some did their best, but caused enumerators great problems when they tried to decipher what had been written. Others passed the task to a child who went to school and was more literate than its parents, but was not always able to fully understand what was required of them.

Yet others left it to the collector to fill in when he arrived, which led to misunderstandings, mis-hearings, mis-spellings and other errors. And after all those problems, not everyone knew the answers to what they were being asked, especially their place or exact year of birth, and just made the best guess they could.

Even if the form was properly completed, mistakes arose when it came to be copied into the official lists by the enumerators. Not all of these were as conscientious as they should have been, and some cut corners – for example, by entering a birthplace for the first entry on a page and then simply writing 'ditto' for all other entries below.

Few enumerators tried to identify individual houses, merely recording them as 'village' and listing them in whatever order they came to hand, which makes it very difficult today to trace their footsteps round a village. It wasn't entirely their fault.

Although house numbering had been introduced in some areas in the 18th century, it had yet to reach places like Dalton, Gayles and Kirby Hill, and in 1841 only a handful of dwellings, usually the grander houses, had names. All the rest were just noted as being 'village'. It was not until the back end of the 19th century that ordinary people started to name the places in which they lived, and even in 1911 most of the recorded dwellings were still anonymous.

However, despite all the problems, omissions and mistakes, the census records remain an invaluable and fascinating source of information. We hope that the compilation of this A-Z record will be useful to anyone seeking to trace ancestors in our part of Teesdale. Similar records for Barningham, Scargill, Newsham, Rokeby and Brignall are available in our companion booklets *Counted Volumes 1,2 and 3*

We have done our best to ensure that the details here are accurate, but inevitably there will be some errors or omissions. If you have any amendments or further information, please let us know and we'll correct it for future editions.

## REFLECTIONS

*Respecting the manner in which Entries may be made in the Encouragement Schedule.*

After "City or Borough," write the name, if the District is in a City or Borough; if not, write "Not in any City or Borough." If the name of the town or village does not follow "City or Borough," write the name, if there is a Township in the Parish, else a Village, then "Parish"; if it is a Township, write the name of the Township, and close it with "Parish." If it is Extra-Parochial, close it with "Parish Extra-Parochial," and write "Extra-Parochial" over these words, and close it with "Parish."

In the column headed "Places," with the name of the house [which has a square] or of the greatest other part of the given, is the village, hamlet, or town-mentioned place in which it stands, opposite to the mark denoting each house, the first house in the series, &c., and, next, "the number in every place in the same series." See.

**Houses.**—James houses established or building in the number shown in the Domesl., writing "1 C" or "1 B" in the case may be in the proper column, opposite to the total number in which each house occurs. Every house which is unoccupied at the time of your visit, and is believed not to have been slept in the night before, may be deemed unoccupied. New houses, as yet established, may be entered as "Building." When there is no one of any house in the total number over 100,000, add the letter "B" instead of the comma, separating the parts.

By "house" is meant dwelling-house, and every building in which any person habitually sleeps and is regarded as a dwelling-house; but buildings, such as stables or warehouses, or any other, which have some kind of intended to be used as dwellings, must not be inserted.

"Names of such Persons who chose theirin the preceding night."—Invert, without pronouns or articles, every living person who chose or slept there. Then add to this name, last letter omitted, the name of the place where he chose or slept there, so as still end "your choice." The day after the other that has been named, add the name of the house, and put no others before them. As long as you can, do the same to no repeat, but write "etc." Where there are more identical names than one, "John Williams," or "Michael Williams," write down only the last.

c. When the person has a first or second name, this may be written instead of the name. The words "Look," "Look again," "Look again," may be put before the names of those to which they belong.

If a lodger has been given two beds write "W. B." for *two beds*, as in the Example. If a man lodged in a lodging-house or inn, a person who slept there the night before, has given two beds, write "W. B." where the name should have been.

As the end of the names of each name tree a sign thus  $\checkmark$  is the Examples. At the end of the names of the names is such always a double line  $\checkmark\checkmark$ .

"Age" and "Size." While the age of each person opposite to the name is one of the two columns headed "Age," and "Size," according to the title.

With the ages of every person under 15 years of age as it stands to you. For persons aged 15 years or over, write the letters of the basis of which persons were aged:

If no more than 10% of any group has the same last digit as "0", "1", "2", or "3", then 100% of the numbers is.

"Prohibition, Trade, Employment, or of Independent Means."—Men, or women, or single persons, having no profession or calling, but living at their means, may be termed as independent, which they are when about one-half."

The professor, his, or hers, or of sons or daughters living with their husbands or parents, and residing there without apprenticeship or receiving wages, need not be deducted.

All persons serving in His Majesty's Land Service, including all persons in the Line, Cavalry, Royal Engineers, or Artillery, may be referred to as "Army," without any reference to their rank, using "R.L." in Majors and "P." in Privates.

## SORTING OUT THE ABRVTNS

*THE first page of the 1841 enumerator's notebook – see previous page – carried lengthy directions for how the census should be carried out.*

*Much of it is straightforward, and it explains some of the mysterious abbreviations you might come across when searching through the records. MS, for example, means manservant, FS female servant. Others include Ag Lab - Agricultural labourer, Ap - Apprentice, C - Clerk, F - Foreigner, I - Irish, Ind - Living on independent means, J - Journeyman, M - Manufacturer; m - maker (as in shoe-m.), P - pensioner (army or navy), S - Scots and Sh - Shopman.*

*No titles were to be recorded – “Rank, or any such term as ‘Esq’ or ‘Gentleman’ must not be entered”, say the directions sternly – except those of the upper classes: “Where the person is a Peer or Peeress the title may be written instead of the name. The words ‘Lord’, ‘Lady’, ‘Sir’, ‘Rt Hon’ and ‘Hon’ may be put before the names of those to whom they belong.”*

## SEVEN QUESTIONS

*THE first census form asked for seven pieces of information about every dwelling and the people there that night:*

- *The address*
- *Whether the dwelling was inhabited*
- *If so, the names of everyone there*
- *Their age and sex*
- *Their profession, trade or employment, if any*
- *Whether they were born in the county in which they were recorded*
- *Whether they were born outside England or Wales.*

## IS HE A LUNATIC?

*THE 1861 census introduced a new question, asking whether people were blind, deaf or dumb. Nobody minded, and those who were disabled in this way were, as far as we can tell, accurately recorded.*

*Encouraged by this, those in charge in 1871 extended the question to ask in addition whether they were an imbecile, an idiot or a lunatic. The response this time was quite different. Nobody wanted to admit that they'd sired a lunatic, and hardly any were recorded.*

*In 1911 they changed the wording to ‘feeble-minded’. This wasn't so bad, and the number of people recorded as having what today would be described as ‘learning difficulties’ soared.*

*They don't ask that kind of question today. Instead they just ask whether the head of the household looks after anyone suffering from longterm mental ill-health or disability.*

## THE SHRINKING VILLAGES

THERE were 120 occupied households listed in the Dalton, Gayles and Kirby Hill census areas in 1841, and the villages had a total population of 551.

Seventy years later, in 1911, the number of homes had shrunk to 82 and the population had dropped by more than a third to 356.

Most of the decline in the number of dwellings took place between 1860 and 1890, when dozens of homes vanished, many of them merged to make bigger houses but some falling into permanent disuse.

The biggest drop in the population also took place in the late Victorian years. The number of males fell from 248 in 1861 to 159 in 1901, reflecting years of agricultural depression, the need for fewer farm workers as machinery was introduced, and the parallel lure of factory work in the towns. The number of females in the village went down, too: there were 248 in 1861, 167 in 1901. The trend reversed slightly at the start of the 20th century, which could have been the result of an increasing demand for domestic servants.

Birth rates fell during this period, as elsewhere in Britain: families of eight or ten were not uncommon in the mid-1800s; by 1911 only a handful of families were recorded with more than six children.

## READING THE LISTS

**E**NTRIES are listed by surname, census year, village identifier (D, G or K), census record number (as on original census records), abode on census day (house names are given where known; otherwise dwellings are identified by family head's surname), number of rooms (1901/1911 only), name and age, then in brackets marital status, relationship to household head, occupation and birthplace. Other household members with different surnames are shown preceded by a + sign, and also listed separately.

In early censuses many ages for adults were rounded down to the nearest five years.

The 1911 census asked how many years a couple had been married and how many children they had had, alive and dead. This is shown in the lists as m15ch3/1 (= married 15 years, three children living, one dead).

In 1881 Abraham Nightman, 41, married, a scavenger born in Bowes, was living at Midden Cottage, numbered 94 in the Kirby Hill census records, with his wife Isabella (39, born in Barningham), their two children Albert (8, born in Bowes) and Mary (6, born in Kirby Hill) and a 16-year-old unmarried servant girl called Agnes Knightley from Bowes.

The birthplaces of the two youngsters suggest that the family moved to the village from Bowes around 1875. As well as being noted here, Agnes will be listed separately, and more details about her could be found by looking her up under Knightley.

By 1891 Abraham had died and his widow was living at Pauper's Cottages with Mary. Albert, unmarried, is working as a farmhand for a family called Brown at Far End Farm, listed No 9 in the Gayles census. More details about them could be found by looking them up on the list.
