THIS booklet has been produced despite the National Archives' decision to sell the 1921 census results to the highest bidder, the website Find My Past UK, who in turn are charging the public up to £3.50 for every single entry they want to see. Viewing all the records for Barningham alone would cost hundreds of pounds, which our local history group cannot possibly afford.

So we have done our best by using Find My Past's own free-search suggestions and have come up with most, though sadly not all, the census contents. Here you will find the names of everyone recorded in Barningham, Scargill, Hope and Newsham in 1921, their ages, birth-places, relationships and fellow householders. Missing are some addresses and most occupations, but many of these can be identified by reference to our earlier census booklets.

We've added results from the Barningham population survey carried out in 1939 as part of the country's preparations for war, and a selection of entries from the Barningham and Hope electoral rolls from 1920 to 1950.

The 1931 census files were lost in a fire and the 1941 census was cancelled, so it will be 2052 before we see any more results. We hope by then the National Archives will be operating less commercially.

# READING THE LISTS

CENSUS entries are listed by surname, first name and age; then (in brackets) relationship to household head, marital status, occupation and birthplace. Other household members with different surnames are shown in italics preceded by a + sign, and are also listed separately.

Abraham Nightman, 41, a scavenger born in Bowes, was living at Midden Cottage, Barningham, with his wife Isabella (39, born in the village), their two children Albert, 7, and Mary, 5, his widowed mother-in-law Martha Taggard, born in Newsham, and a servant girl called Agnes Knightley, born in Scargill.

The birthplaces of the two youngsters suggest that the family moved to the village from Bowes around 1917.

As well as being noted with the Nightman family, Martha and Agnes are listed separately and more details about them can be found by looking them up under Taggard and White: Martha is Isabella's widowed mother, Agnes is a niece, unmarried and working as a domestic servant.

Our other publications (see last page) include Counted volumes 1 to 4 covering the censuses from 1841 to 1911, which may help you to find more information about these people in earlier records.
