This week it was confirmed that the Alternative Fuel Payment of £200 will be made in the New Year. For many this may still be paid via their electricity provider, however, more details are expected soon. UKIFDA, the trade body for the liquid fuel distribution industry, welcomed this update: "This extra clarity is important as it means customers can plan their budgets accordingly". Going on to advise: "We continue to strongly advise customers to purchase their heating oil as usual ahead of cold weather. Importantly, you'll receive this payment even if you order your heating oil today, so there's no need to delay your order any longer."






