North Yorkshire police have a new community messenger / neighbourhood alert system where you will receive an email / text message making yourselves aware / updated about any police matters within the area, e.g. alerts of new scams or a crime such as a burglary within the area.

NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH: SECURING YOUR E-MAIL ACCOUNT

Your email password: using a combination of 3 random words creates passwords that are long enough and strong enough. Avoid words that can be guessed, like your pet's name or birth month. Adding numbers and symbols is a good way to make your password even harder to guess.

Turn on 2-Step Verification (2SV) for your email: 2-Step Verification (2SV) gives you twice the protection so even if cyber criminals have your password, they can't access your email. It works by asking for more information to prove your identity. For example, getting a code sent to your phone when you sign in using a new device or change settings such as your password. You won't be asked for this every time you check your email.

RIVER FLIES

Following the recent pollution incident to the Holme Beck, some local residents have been working with Gilling West Fly Fishers, the Yorkshire Dales Rivers Trust and others to set up river fly monitoring of the watercourses that converge and flow into the Swale. The river flies are invertebrates which are an important part of the aquatic ecosystem and food chain. There is a national scheme (the Anglers Riverfly Monitoring Initiative) that uses a standardised method of monitoring target river fly species as an indicator for river health. This data is made available to the rivers trusts and Environment Agency and complements their work. It can also be used to detect pollution incidents and sources.

We have organised two 1-day courses at Gilling West Village Hall in late July to train new volunteers. Afterwards, volunteers (working in pairs) will be assigned a location on the Holmedale catchment to monitor once a month. A typical monitoring session takes about 1-3 hours.

There are a couple of places still available on the training courses if you are interested in taking part. Please contact me for further information.
