Neighbourhood Alert:

"Quishing": QR codes are becoming increasingly common; scanning to pay for parking, or receiving an email asking to verify an online account. However cyber criminals are increasingly using quishing as a way to trick the public out of their personal and financial information. What can you do avoid being a victim of quishing?

- QR codes used in pubs or restaurants are usually safe to scan.
- Scanning QR codes in open spaces (like stations and car parks) might pose a greater risk. Check for signs that codes may have been tampered with (usually by a sticker placed over the legitimate QR code). If in doubt, do not scan them; use a search engine to find the official website or app for the organisation to which you need to make a payment.
- If you receive an email with a QR code in it and you're asked to scan it, you should be cautious due to an increase in these types of 'quishing' attacks.
- Finally, we recommend that you use the QR-scanner that comes with your phone, rather than using an app downloaded from an app store.
